

Environmental Policy

lux-Airport, as the aerodrome operator of Luxembourg Airport, strives to minimise the impact of the airport's activity on the surrounding ecosystems and to develop infrastructures in harmony with the local communities.

Climate change is a reality and is everyone's responsibility: every step taken towards reducing greenhouse gas emissions counts. In line with this mission statement, lux-Airport is implementing an environment management system in its business strategy.

lux-Airport is seeking to continuously reduce the environmental impacts of its activities and operations, with a focus on the following topics:

1. Reducing our energy consumption:

- Ongoing energy management strategy for the terminal: checks on existing facilities, adjustments and optimisations, investing in new technologies such as dimmable LED lighting in parking facilities.
- Improvement of the thermal envelope of buildings
- Renovation of heating systems

2. Reducing our Carbon footprint:

- Commitment to the Airport Carbon Accreditation programme in order to become neutral by 2021
- Lean & Green certification with the aim of achieving a 20% reduction in our carbon footprint by 2021
- E-mobility:
 - car charging station installed in the underground car park
 - 100% electric car rental contract negotiated
 - electric buses serve the airport car parks
- We already buy only renewable electricity, 100 % hydroelectricity.
- We promote the use of renewable energy in all new premises

3. Water management:

- Continuous analysis of water pollution levels with five stations
- Treatment of polluted water and improvement of the treatment yield
- Further development of environmental emergency management procedures

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4. Waste management:

- Continuous reduction of waste production at the source
- Increase of the recycling rate
- Information and awareness-raising actions on the topic of waste sorting targeted at the staff
- Promoting re-usable items. Staff no longer use plastics cups.
- We have obtained the SuperDrecksKëscht label to ensure optimum management.

5. Soil conservation:

- A land use plan of the different zones will be drawn up, enabling the necessary anti-pollution measures to be taken with a view to guaranteeing a healthy environment and preventing contamination.
- Upon cessation of activity: soil analysis and restoration

6. Biodiversity:

- Improving the existing biodiversity through studies
- Promoting preservation by setting up projects:
 - Each new project is set off by creating a new area with the same ecological level
 - Bee hives set up in cooperation with the ANA
 - Glyphosate is no longer used anywhere in the airport

7. Environmental awareness:

- Educating lux-Airport employees on the airport's specific environmental priorities.
- Carrying out environmental awareness campaigns aimed at passengers
- Encouraging the uptake of best practices among the airport's various stakeholders, e.g. airlines, cargo lines, catering companies, etc.

lux-Airport will implement an action plan with a long-term vision toward 2025 in order to guide the implementation of the various projects and to ensure that it is able to achieve the objectives that it has set itself.

The environmental management system integrates into the company's management practices, leading to constant revisions and improvements to methods and thus providing the keys to greater success.
